Welcome to York Harbor, Maine! Here is some information that you might find helpful when you are ashore.

Yacht Club Dock Tie-Up

If you are arriving by dinghy after 6pm, please tie up on the back (street) side of the docks – to the right as you look at shore - keeping the front of the dock open. Contact: AYC (207) 363-8510 www.aycsail.org

Moorings for the Night

AYC unfortunately does not have guest mooring, but they are available through the Town of York and the Harbor Master. Anchoring is no longer allowed in York Harbor. The town has a few transient moorings, which are assigned and rented by the harbormaster (Ch. 09, 16).

The seasonal number at the Town Dock 2 Harbormaster offices is (207) 363-0433. The Town does not provide water, electrical services, trash or wastewater disposal, however, within York Harbor, there are multiple private entities that do provide such services

If you can't reach the harbormaster, York Harbor Marine (207) 363-3602 on Harris Island or Donnell's Marine (207) 363-4308) to the north may be able to help.

There is no wastewater disposal service provided in York Harbor. Please review the Maine Pump-out Station and No Discharge Area Guide issued by Maine Department of Environmental Protection here:

Live Lobsters

Donnell's Lobsters. From the AYC dock, turn left and then a short 100 yard walk along the shore to the second wharf at the end of Barrell Lane. There is a small store that sells live lobsters. You'll have to cook them.

York Harbor Marine

York Harbor Marine is located directly across the harbor from AYC. York Harbor Marine Service provides a fuel dock with unleaded gasoline and diesel ValvTect marine fuels, potable water, electricity, coin-operated laundry, showers and restrooms, as well as limited transient space during operating hours, which change seasonally (Monday-Saturday 8 AM to 4:30 PM, Sunday 9 AM to 4 PM, closed on Sundays after Labor Day). Restaurants within Walking Distance

There are 3 restaurants that are within walking distance. The York Harbor Inn has the Cellar Pub which is informal and upstairs which is a more formal restaurant. Across the harbor near the York Harbor Marine is the Dockside Restaurant. The third dinner location is The Stage Neck Inn. For breakfast and coffee, there is Rick's All Season Restaurant and the Bagel Basket in York Village, which is about 1.25 miles away.

Grocery Stores

Beside Rick's is a Cumberland Farms store that has some groceries, ice, and beer/wine (about 1.25 miles). There is a larger Hannaford's grocery store, but this is about 3 miles away.

Churches

There is the St. Georges (Episcopal) located on York Street and the Trinity (Unitarian) Church located on York and Woodbridge. St. Christopher (Catholic) Church on Barrell Lane, and the First Parish (Congregational) Church on York Street in York Village (1.3 miles)
